MESSAGE FROM THE MITCHELL FAMILY

When Gordon passed away, 10 years ago, we were challenged to move on and to find a way to channel the immense love that we had for him into something positive.

We chose to focus on three initiatives, the first was to leave a legacy through student awards, the second was to increase awareness around the lack of adverse drug reporting and finally to raise the awareness of off-label use of pharmaceutical drugs (especially in pediatric populations).

With the tremendous support of our friends, family, community and from Olds High School we are proud of the five student awards that have been established in Gordon's name. To date, 44 youth have received awards ranging from \$250 - \$500 each for a total of \$13,500.

Gordon was passionate about welding and sports so it's no surprise that three of the awards reflect his interests. The Spirit Awards (2008) reflect our beliefs regarding the standards of humanity, care and dignity needed in society.

With regard to the other two goals, we have been able to participate in raising the awareness around the lack of reporting on adverse drug reactions, however, we acknowledge that there is still a lot of work to do regarding 'off label' pharmaceutical prescribing.

Thank you for your support during the past 10 years. Gordon continues to live on in our hearts and in our community through the youth who benefit from the memorial fund.

This Memorial Fund honors Gordon Mitchell (Grade 11 student at Olds Jr. Sr. High School) who passed away December 29, 2003 at the age of 16.

Five (5) awards are awarded annually (to students from Olds High School) from gifts made by family, friends and faculty.
